BUT THE DUTCH GOVERNMENT DIDN'T GIVE HIM A PERMIT. AFGHANISTAN IS SAFE, THEY SAY. M. IS ON THE STREET NOW, ILLEGALLY. WITHOUT WORK, MONEY OR A DECENT FUTURE. M. IS ON THE LIST TO BE SEND BACK TO AFGHANISTAN.

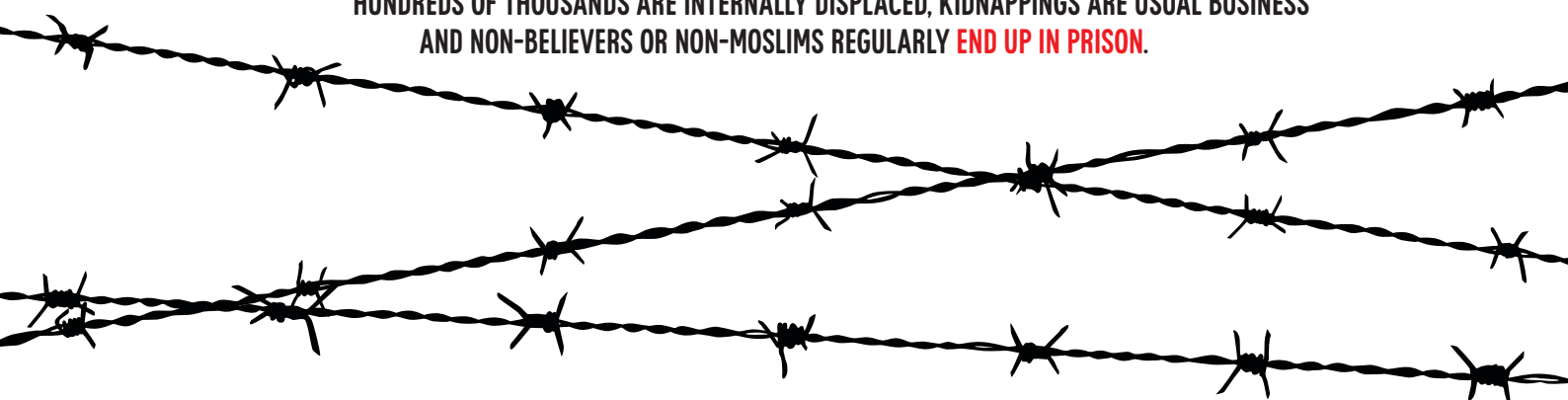
AFGHANISTAN IS NOT SAFE!

OVER THE PAST NEARLY 15 YEARS **MORE THEN 111,000 PEOPLE HAVE BEEN KILLED**
AND MORE THAN 116,000 PEOPLE HAVE BEEN INJURED IN THE WAR IN AFGHANISTAN.

ACCORDING TO THE GLOBAL PEACE INDEX (GPI) 2017 AFGHANISTAN IS SECOND AFTER SYRIA
WHEN IT COMES TO **THE MOST UNSAFEST PLACES IN THE WORLD.**

THE UN CLASSIFIED AFGHANISTAN FROM A POST-CONFLICT COUNTRY
TO ONE IN **ACTIVE CONFLICT**, WHICH MEANS WAR.

HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS ARE INTERNALLY DISPLACED, KIDNAPPINGS ARE USUAL BUSINESS
AND NON-BELIEVERS OR NON-MOSLIMS REGULARLY **END UP IN PRISON.**

in which more than ten civilians were killed. Soldiers, policemen and government officials who died in conflict and attack uptill now are not mentioned here.

- 27 JANUARY** An ambulance with explosives blew up in a crowded street in Kabul, killing more than 103 people and injured more than 235 people. Taliban claims responsibility.
- 24 JANUARY** ISIS militants attacked the offices of British aid agency Save the Children in Jalalabad, killing five people and injuring dozens.
- 21 JANUARY** 22 people (foreigners and Afghan) died in an attack by Taliban on the Intercontinental Hotel, Kabul.
- 31 DECEMBER** A bomb exploded at a funeral gathering in Jalalabad (Nangarhar province) killing at least 18 people and wounding at least 15 others.
- 28 DECEMBER** Islamic State has killed at least 41 people and injured more than 80 others in an attack on a Shia cultural centre and news agency in Kabul.
- 17-19 OCTOBER** The Taliban launched four complex attacks around the country using Humvees rigged as suicide bombs, killing more than 100 people, including both Afghan National Defence and Security Forces personnel and civilians.
- 21 OCTOBER** More than 60 people have been killed and dozens more wounded in two separate attacks on mosques in Kabul and Ghor.
- 25 AUGUST** A suicide bombing followed by gunfire as Shia Muslims gathered for Friday prayers at a mosque in Kabul killed at least 28 people and injured at least 50 people, with ISIL claiming responsibility.
- 5 AUGUST** The Taliban and ISIS jointly killed more than 50 men, women and children in a village in the remote Sayad district of northern Sar-e Pul province.
- 2 AUGUST** Suicide attackers killed at least 29 Shia worshippers in the western province of Herat.
- 24 JULY** At least 35 people have been killed and more than 40 wounded after a suicide car bomb targeted a bus carrying ministry staff in Kabul, the capital of Afghanistan.
- 22 JUNE** At least 29 people have been killed and 60 were wounded after a car bomb exploded outside a bank in Lashkar Gah, capital of Helmand.
- 31 MAY** A massive truck bomb blast has ripped through the heart of Kabul's diplomatic district, killing at least 90 people and wounding more than 300 in a powerful explosion described by officials as "one of the biggest" to have hit the capital of Afghanistan.
