in which more than ten civilians were killed. Soldiers, policemen and government officials who died in conflict and attack uptill now are not mentioned here.

27 JANUARY	An ambulance with explosives blew up in a crowded street in Kabul, killing more then103 people and injured more then 235 people. Taliban claims responsibility.
24 JANUARY	ISIS militants attacked the offices of British aid agency Save the Children in Jalalabad, killing five people and injuring dozens.
21 JANUARY	22 people (foreigners and Afghan) died in an attack by Taliban on the Intercontinental Hotel, Kabul.
31 DECEMBER	A bomb exploded at a funeral gathering in Jalalabad (Nangarhar province) killing at least 18 people and wounding at least 15 others.
28 DECEMBER	Islamic State has killed at least 41 people and injured more than 80 others in an attack on a Shia cultural centre and news agency in Kabul.
17-19 OCTOBER	The Taliban launched four complex attacks around the country using Humvees rigged as suicide bombs, killing more than 100 people, including both Afghan National Defence and Security Forces personnel and civilians.
21 OCTOBER	More than 60 people have been killed and dozens more wounded in two separate attacks on mosques in Kabul and Ghor.
25 AUGUST	A suicide bombing followed by gunfire as Shia Muslims gathered for Friday prayers at a mosque in Kabul killed at least 28 people and injured at least 50 people, with ISIL claiming responsibility.
5 AUGUST	The Taliban and ISIS jointly killed more then 50 men, women and children in a village in the remote Sayad district of northern Sar-e Pul province.
2 AUGUST	Suicide attackers killed at least 29 Shia worshippers in the western province of Herat.
24 JULY	At least 35 people have been killed and more than 40 wounded after a suicide car bomb targeted a bus carrying ministry staff in Kabul, the capital of Afghanistan.
22 JUNE	At least 29 people have been killed and 60 were wounded after a car bomb exploded outside a bank in Lashkar Gah, capital of Helmand.
31 MAY	A massive truck bomb blast has ripped through the heart of Kabul's diplomatic district, killing at least 90 people and wounding more then 300 in a powerful explosion described by officials as "one of the biggest"

to have hit the capital of Afghanistan.
