

AFGHANISTAN IS NOT SAFE!

OVER THE PAST 15 YEARS, MORE THAN 111,000 PEOPLE HAVE BEEN KILLED AND OVER 116,000 PEOPLE HAVE BEEN INJURED IN THE WAR IN AFGHANISTAN. ACCORDING TO THE GLOBAL PEACE INDEX 2017, AFGHANISTAN IS SECOND AFTER SYRIA WHEN IT COMES TO THE MOST UNSAFE COUNTRY WORLDWIDE. THE UN CLASSIFIED AFGHANISTAN FROM A POST-CONFLICT COUNTRY TO ONE IN ACTIVE CONFLICT, IN OTHER WORDS: WAR. HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE ARE INTERNALLY DISPLACED, KIDNAPPINGS ARE COMMONPLACE, AND NON-BELIEVERS OR NON-MUSLIMS REGULARLY END UP IN PRISON.

MAIN ATTACKS 1 MAY 2017 - 9 MAY 2018

in which more than ten civilians were killed. Soldiers, policemen and government officials are not included.

2018

- 9 MAY** Insurgents killed at least 15 people in three separate attacks in Kabul, claimed by IS and Taliban and six policemen died in an airstrike for which officials blamed the American military.
- 30 APRIL** 36 killed in twin blasts in Kabul and Khost province, including nine journalists. IS claims responsibility.
- 22 APRIL** An IS bomber kills 60 people and injures 129, all civilians, outside a voter registration centre amid preparations for legislative elections in October.
- 2 APRIL** A UN report has found that 30 children were killed and 51 injured in an Afghan air strike in Kunduz.
- 21 MARCH** More than 30 people, mostly teenagers, are killed when an IS suicide bomber blows himself up as Afghans celebrate the Persian new year holiday.
- 9 MARCH** An IS suicide bomber blows himself up in a Shia area, killing at least nine people and wounding 18.
- 27 JANUARY** An ambulance with explosives explodes in a crowded street in Kabul, killing more than 103 people and injuring more than 235. Taliban claims responsibility.
- 24 JANUARY** Isis militants attack the offices of British aid agency Save the Children in Jalalabad, killing five people and injuring dozens.
- 21 JANUARY** 22 people (foreigners and Afghan) die in a Taliban attack on the Intercontinental Hotel, Kabul.

2017

- 31 DECEMBER** A bomb explodes at a funeral gathering in Jalalabad (Nangarhar province) killing at least 18 people and wounding at least 15 others.
- 28 DECEMBER** IS kills at least 41 people and injures more than 80 others in an attack on a Shia cultural centre and news agency in Kabul.
- 21 OCTOBER** More than 60 people are killed and dozens more wounded in two separate attacks on mosques in Kabul and Ghor.
- 25 AUGUST** An IS suicide bombing followed by gunfire as Shia Muslims gathered for Friday prayers at a mosque in Kabul kills at least 28 people and injured at least 50.
- 5 AUGUST** Taliban and IS jointly kill more than 50 men, women and children in a village in the remote Sayad district of northern Sar-e Pul province.
- 2 AUGUST** Suicide attackers kill at least 29 Shia worshippers in Herat.
- 24 JULY** At least 35 people are killed and more than 40 wounded after a suicide car bomb targeted a bus carrying ministry staff in Kabul.
- 22 JUNE** At least 29 people are killed and 60 wounded after a car bomb explodes outside a bank in Lashkar Gah, capital of Helmand.
- 31 MAY** A massive truck bomb blast rips through the heart of Kabul's diplomatic district, killing at least 90 people and wounding more than 300 in a powerful explosion described by officials as "one of the biggest" to have hit the capital of Afghanistan.
